CANCELLATION POLICY

Cancellation is permitted (less a \$50 administration fee) provided notice is given no less than 7 days prior to the first day of camp. No refund will be given with less than 7 days notice unless a doctor's note is provided.

Supervision is provided from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm. Should you require additional care, the cost is \$5 per ½ hour and arrangements must be made at time of registration.
