> A year without live theatre. A year of planning and pivoting. Pandemic restrictions forced us to all work from home, and to engage young people outside, behind glass, and online. We applied for funding to sustain us, to help adapt to new platforms, to rethink our internal culture, and build our organisational capacity. We asked and hired our family of artists to provide advice, explore and develop theatre. and train for online drama education. We overhauled our website and increased our social media output to remain connected to our stakeholders. Our year was filled with much reflection, many new insights, and unexpected creative advances despite the fact we had one single encounter we could call live performance. As we anticipate a future that celebrates live theatre again, we are eternally grateful for our funders, our Teacher Advisory, our Artists, our Staff, and Board for their perseverance and support of Quest Theatre. 
